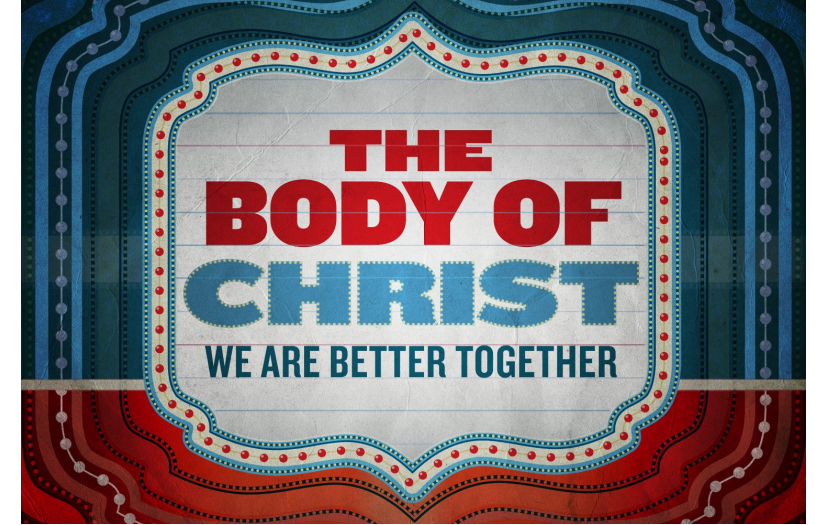
#### **Mission's Sewing Basket**
